# Registration Information and Procedures For 2017-2018

Every year, personal information may change for families (e-mails, phone numbers, addresses, etc.); therefore, we ask that ALL FAMILIES fill out a registration form every year so that our system may be updated.

- Complete the 2017-2018 Religious Education Registration form.
- Enclose a copy of your child/ren's Baptism Certificate (unless baptized at Immaculate Conception Parish or previously turned in)
- Enclose the appropriate registration fee (see below) (Check or MO payable to ICC)
- If your child attended classes in a different parish last year, please obtain a "Transfer Letter" from that parish (We require that there be a copy on file with the Religious Education Office since additional sacraments cannot be conferred upon your child until their Baptism has been verified by a signed and churched stamped certificate.)
- **Both Catholic School and Homeschool children who will be receiving their Sacraments at Immaculate Conception need to register.**

You may e-mail the form; drop it in the Sunday Collection basket; or snail mail to PO Box 166, Mechanicsville, MD 20659.

CLASS SCHEDULES: Religious Education classes Grades K-8 are held on Sunday mornings, with Session A beginning at 8:00 AM until 8:50 AM and Session B beginning at 10:00AM until 10:50 AM. Families may choose the session that best suits their needs, **BUT ONCE A CLASS IS FILLED, THE OTHER SESSION WILL BE THE ONE A FAMILY IS REGISTERED IN. REMEMBER FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED.** This schedule allows families to attend Mass either before or after Religious Education classes.

FEES:

- 1 child, \$50
- 2 children, \$70
- 3 or more children, \$80

Extra amount due at Registration for Sacraments: 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade First Holy Communion is \$40; 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Confirmation is \$30, **and** \$50 if attending the Retreat.
